Workshops

We will hold four workshops to assist you with your racers. If you need assistance with design, cutting, wheel alignment, weight issues, etc, this is the place to be. A short test track will be available too. Workshops will be held at the Clopper's Mill West Clubhouse on the following (Saturday) dates: January 14, 21, 28, and February 4. Hours will be 11am to 4pm. All tools will be provided. Additional hardware such as weight, axels and wheels will be available in limited quantities.

Preregistration

All race cars will be required to be preregistered prior to the day of the race.
No registrations will be accepted on the day of the race.

Registrations will be held at the Clopper's Mill West Club House on February 8 and 9 from 6 to 9pm. Registration consists of weight and dimension verification. Once the racer has passed the inspection, the car will be turned over to a race official.

A small maintenance area will be set up to allow for modifications in the event that the racer does not meet race requirements. Additional weight, glue, graphite, etc. will be available. Pre registration is not a workshop. Please do not show up with a car kit and expect to register.

On race day your car will be displayed for judging by fellow scouts. This will be followed by a heap of great racing.
